

Notice of Completion Environmental Screening

Two 10.0MW Wind Turbine Projects

Ashton Ridge Golf Course Project & Ashton Ridge Wind Farm Project F

East Luther Grand Valley Township

Grand Valley Wind Farms Inc. is proposing to construct a total of twelve wind power turbines divided into two projects for a maximum of 10.0MW for each project. The projects are to be located on 1,010 acres of agricultural land the Company has leased in the Township of East Luther Grand Valley. As a requirement prior to construction, the project is subject to the Ministry of the Environment's Environmental Screening Process for Electricity projects over 2.0MW. The projects will be located on the Lots 29, 30, 31 & 32, Concession 6, 7 & 8, Township of East Luther Grand Valley, County of Dufferin (See map opposite).

An Environmental Screening Report ("ESR") has been prepared as required under Ontario Regulation 116/01 of the Environmental Assessment Act. The ESR was completed as required for a Category B project under the "Guide to Environmental Assessment Requirements for Electricity Projects, March 2001" ("EA Guide"), as released by the Ontario Ministry of the Environment's ("MOE") Environmental Assessment and Approvals Branch.

The proposed project has been reviewed in a process consistent with the MOE's Environmental Screening Process for electricity projects, the results of which are described in the Ashton Ridge Golf Course Wind Farm Project ESR (February 2007). The results of the ESR indicate that there are no significant negative effects; Grand Valley Wind Farms Inc. intends to proceed with the project.

In compliance with Ontario Regulation 116/01 the ESR must be made available for a minimum 30-calendar day stakeholder review period. Thus, this ESR is being made available for review and comment from March 1, 2007 through to March 30, 2007.

As per the process outlined in the EA Guide, stakeholders must first attempt to resolve any outstanding issues with Grand Valley Wind Farms Inc. during the 30-calendar day period. In the event that issues cannot be resolved with Grand Valley Wind Farms Inc. during the review period the concerned party may make a written request, to the Director of the MOE's Environmental Assessment and Approvals Branch at the address noted below, to elevate the project to either an Environmental Review or Individual Environmental Assessment. A copy of the elevation request must also be sent to Grand Valley Wind Farms at one of the two addresses noted above.
