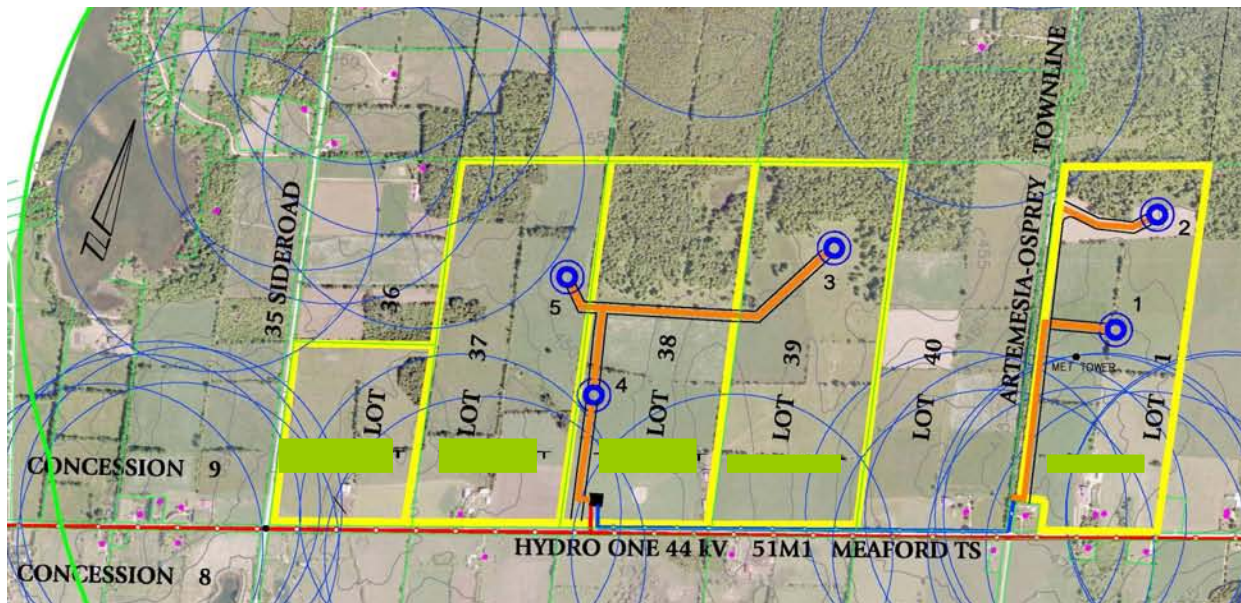


Correction on Notice of Completion – Flesherton Wind Farm Project

Please note that the Notice of Completion is being re-issued to correct a typographical error in the original Notice of Completion. The previous Notice made mention of “Skyway 8 Wind Energy Inc.”. The correct wording, contained in this Notice, is “Flesherton Wind Energy Inc.”. The deadline for comment remains the same as previously published (October 21st, 2009).

Notice of Completion – Environmental Screening Review Flesherton Wind Farm Project, Municipality of Grey Highlands

Flesherton Wind Energy Inc. is proposing to construct five wind power turbines that will generate up to 10 MW of electrical power. The Project is to be located on agricultural land leased in the Municipality of Grey Highlands.



An Environmental Screening Review (“ESR”) report was prepared as required under Ontario Regulation 116/01 of the *Environmental Assessment Act*. The ESR report conforms to the requirements for a Category B project under the “Guide to Environmental Assessment Requirements for Electricity Projects, March 2001” (“EA Guide”), as released by the Ontario Ministry of the Environment’s (“MOE”) Environmental Assessment and Approvals Branch.

The Project has been reviewed in a process consistent with the MOE’s Environmental Screening Process for electricity projects, the results of which are described in the Flesherton Wind Farm ESR (September 2009). The results of the ESR indicate that there are no significant negative effects and Flesherton Wind Energy Inc. intends to proceed with the project.

In compliance with Ontario Regulation 116/01 the ESR must be made available for a minimum 30-calendar day stakeholder review period. Thus, this ESR is being made available for review and comment from September 19th, 2009 through to October 21st, 2009. Hard copies of the ESR may be found during this review period at the following public location: Grey Highlands Public Library, 10 Elizabeth Street, Flesherton, Ontario. As per the process outlined in the EA Guide, stakeholders must first attempt to resolve any outstanding issues with Flesherton Wind Energy Inc. during the 30-calendar day period. All comments and correspondence should be sent to one of the following:

In the event that issues cannot be resolved with Flesherton Wind Energy Inc. during the review period, the concerned party may make a written request, to the Director of the MOE’s Environmental Assessment and Approvals Branch at the address noted below, to elevate the project to either an Environmental Review or Individual Environmental Assessment. A copy of the elevation request must also be sent to Flesherton Wind Energy Inc. and the consultants at the two addresses noted above.

Elevation requests must be made in accordance with the provisions set out in the MOE’s EA Guide and be received by the MOE’s Director of the Environmental Assessment and Approvals Branch, Flesherton Wind Farms Inc., and the consultant no later than 5:00 p.m. on October 21st, 2009.
